

Rice Lake Soccer Association (RLSA) Over Roster Policy

In the event that a RLSA team has too many players on its roster to play in a league/tournament event that limits rosters, the RLSA Board has developed the following policy to determine how players are chosen to be placed on the roster for that jamboree/tournament.

1. The Association/Team will inform families of when jamborees/tournaments are to take place and ask families to commit to these dates.
2. If the number of players is still too many for a specific date, the team will ask for any volunteers who would be willing to not play on the specific date so that an appropriate roster number can be reached.
3. Practice attendance of players, which will be kept by the coach, would be the next criteria to determine who will be on the roster for a specific date. The players who attend practice the most will have the first chance to be on the roster for that date.
4. Players that are signed up after the regular registration dates (late registrants), will be notified at the time of their registration that they may be subject to not being able to play on certain dates, if an appropriate roster cannot be reached from the above three criteria.
5. Final criteria, if above four do not solve the roster issue, is to draw names from a hat to determine the appropriate roster.
